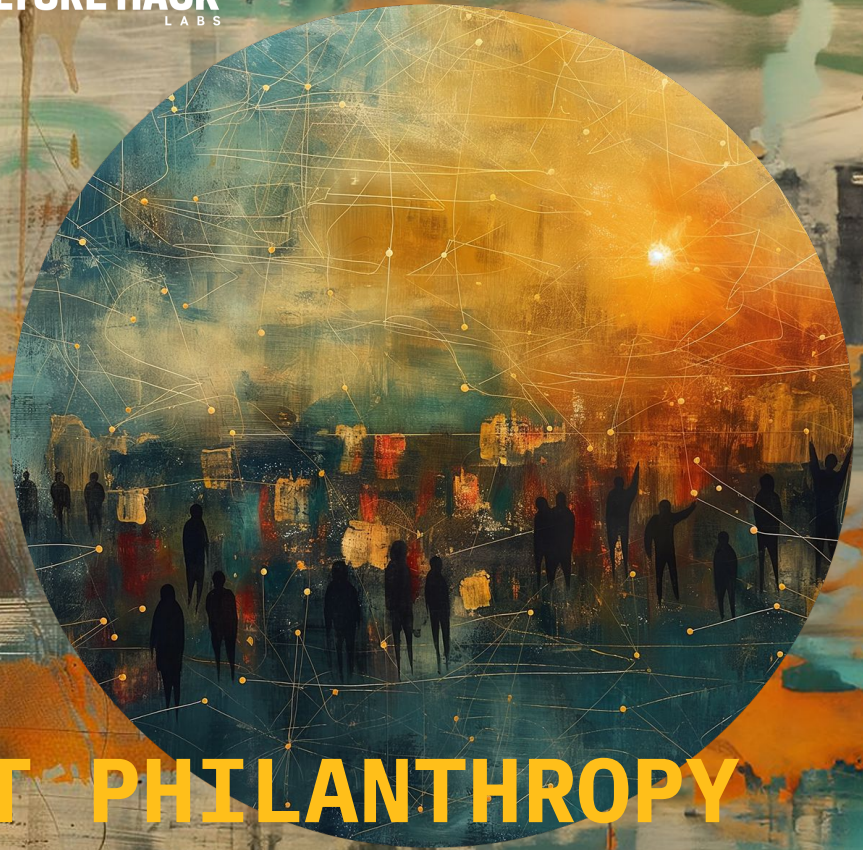

Our mission is to dismantle the cultural narratives that create and justify ecological breakdown, extraction, inequality and poverty.

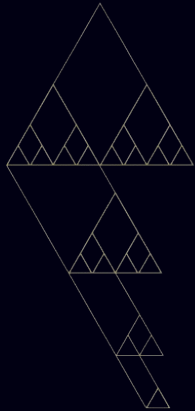

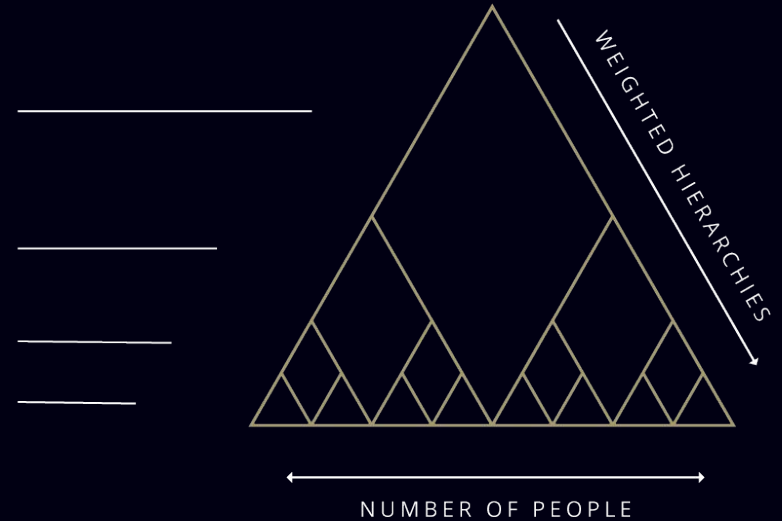
Nested Hierarchies of Dominant Philanthropy

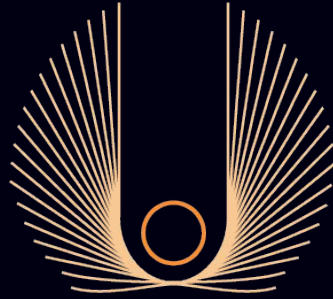


Five Elements Mandala

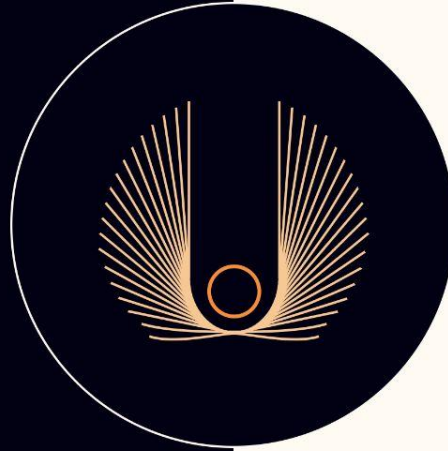

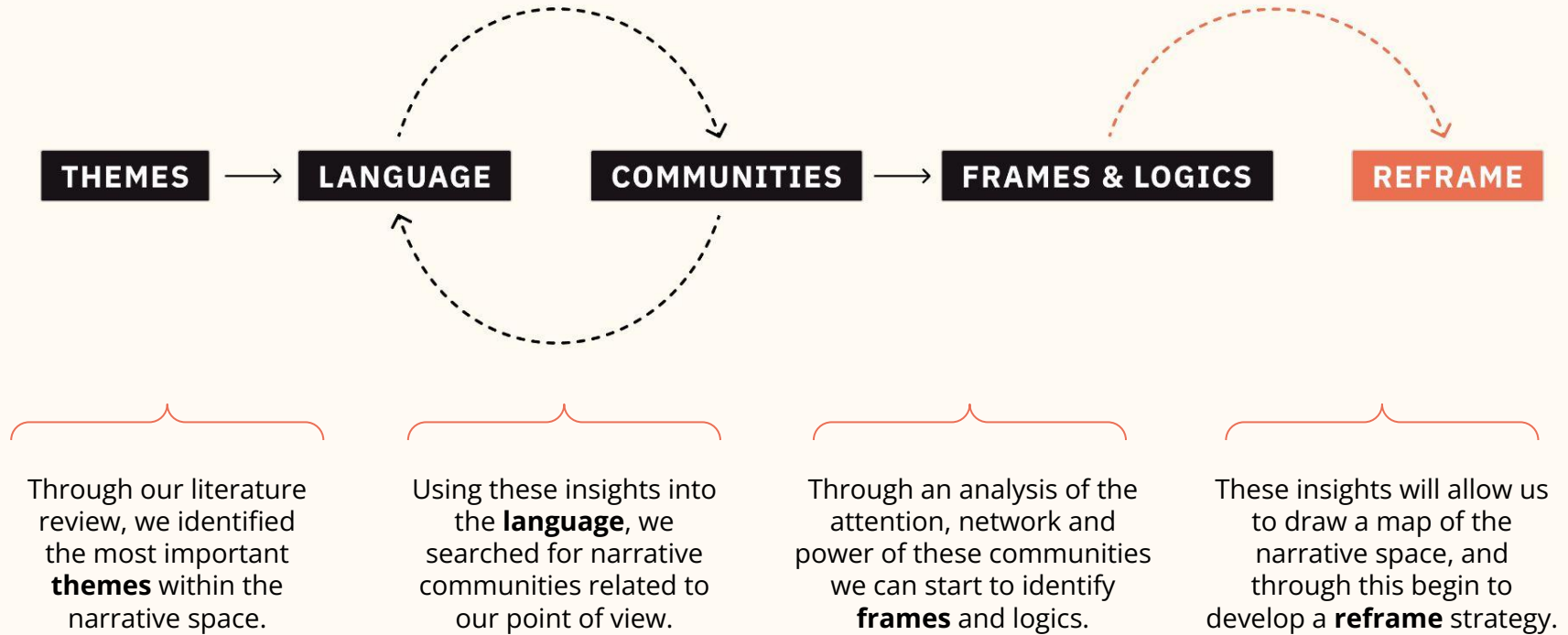

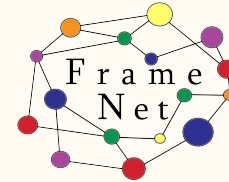




Linguistic Analysis Tools

Through the power of this technology platform and our methodology we can identify the deep logics of the dominant narratives that are often perpetuating colonial, capitalitic and patriarchal logics.

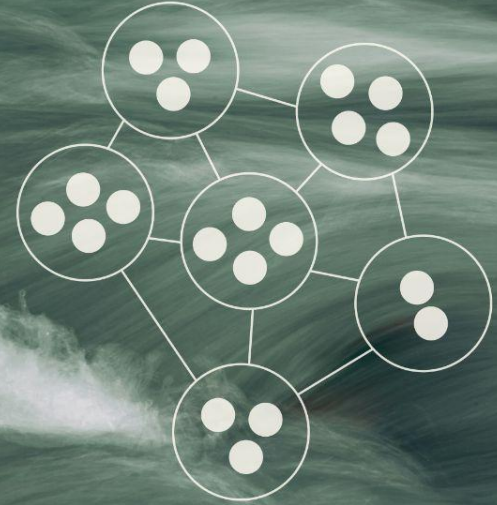
Our approach decolonizes the narratives evolving them into spaces of healing, restoration and transformation.

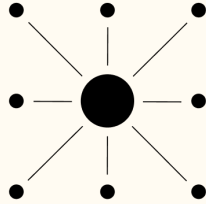


Narratives are interpretive social structures that frame our experience and help us make sense of everyday reality.



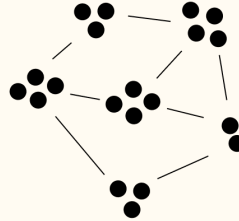
Narrative communities are groups of nodes that are talking to each other about a specific topic, in a similar way.





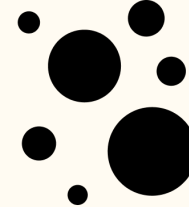
ATTENTION

What and who are the most influential nodes in the network - voices, actors domains, platforms?



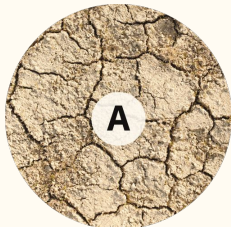
NETWORK

Through the analysis of attention, network and power we can identify the most recurrent language in the community. Through this we can identify **metaphors, logics and frames**.



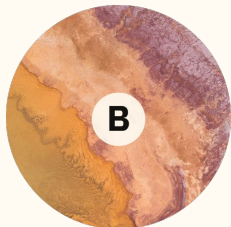

Semantic Frames

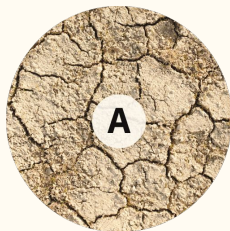
A semantic frame is a conceptual structure that organizes the roles and relationships involved in common situations or actions, aiding in understanding and processing language.

Conceptual Metaphors

A conceptual metaphor, involves understanding complex ideas through simpler, concrete experiences. These metaphors shape how we think, reason, and communicate by linking abstract concepts to basic human experiences.*

*This idea is rooted in "primary metaphors" that emerge from our physical and social experiences, such as "Affection is Warmth" or "Important is Big."

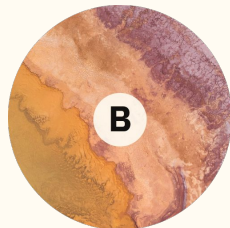

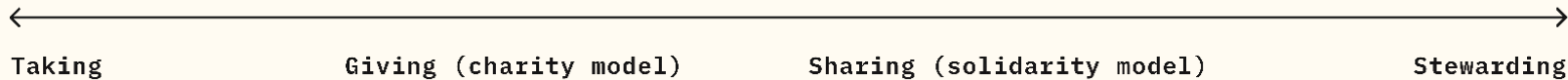


Attitudinal Spectrum

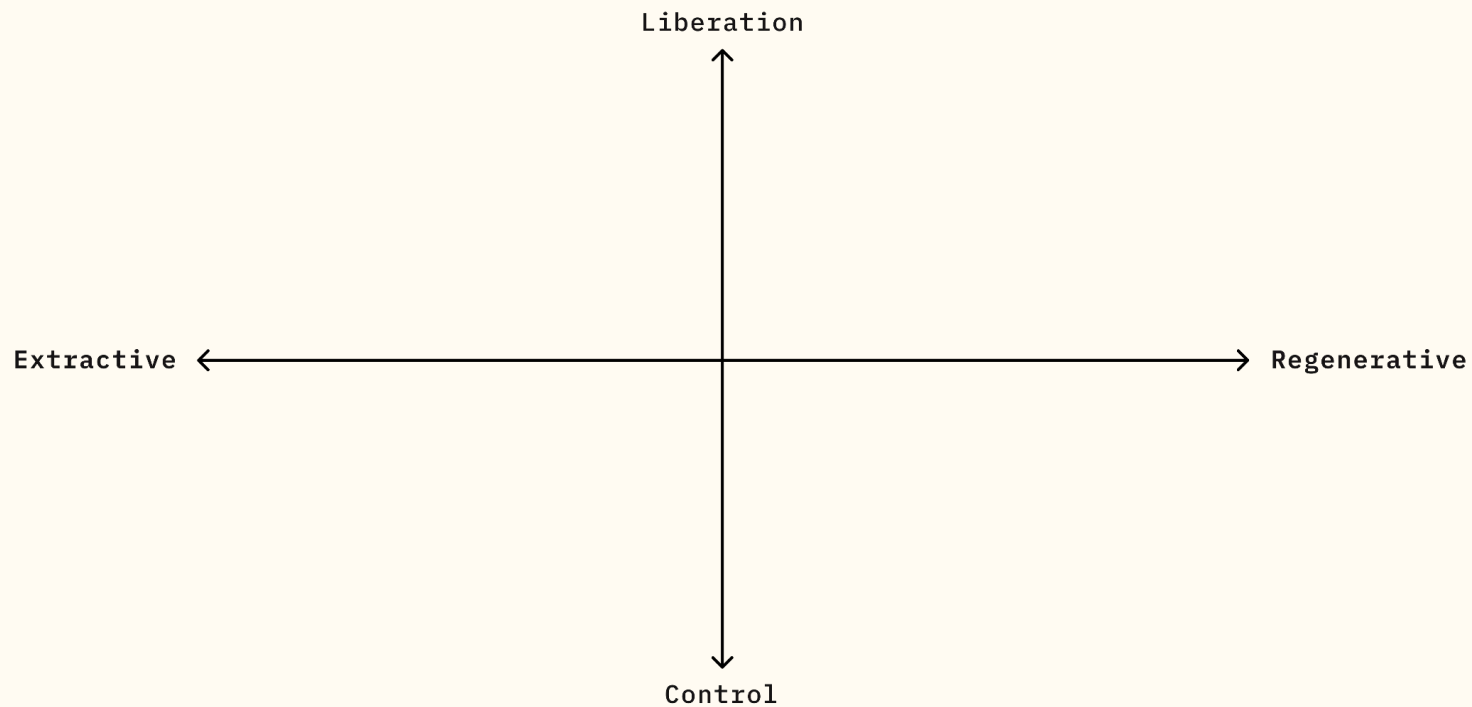

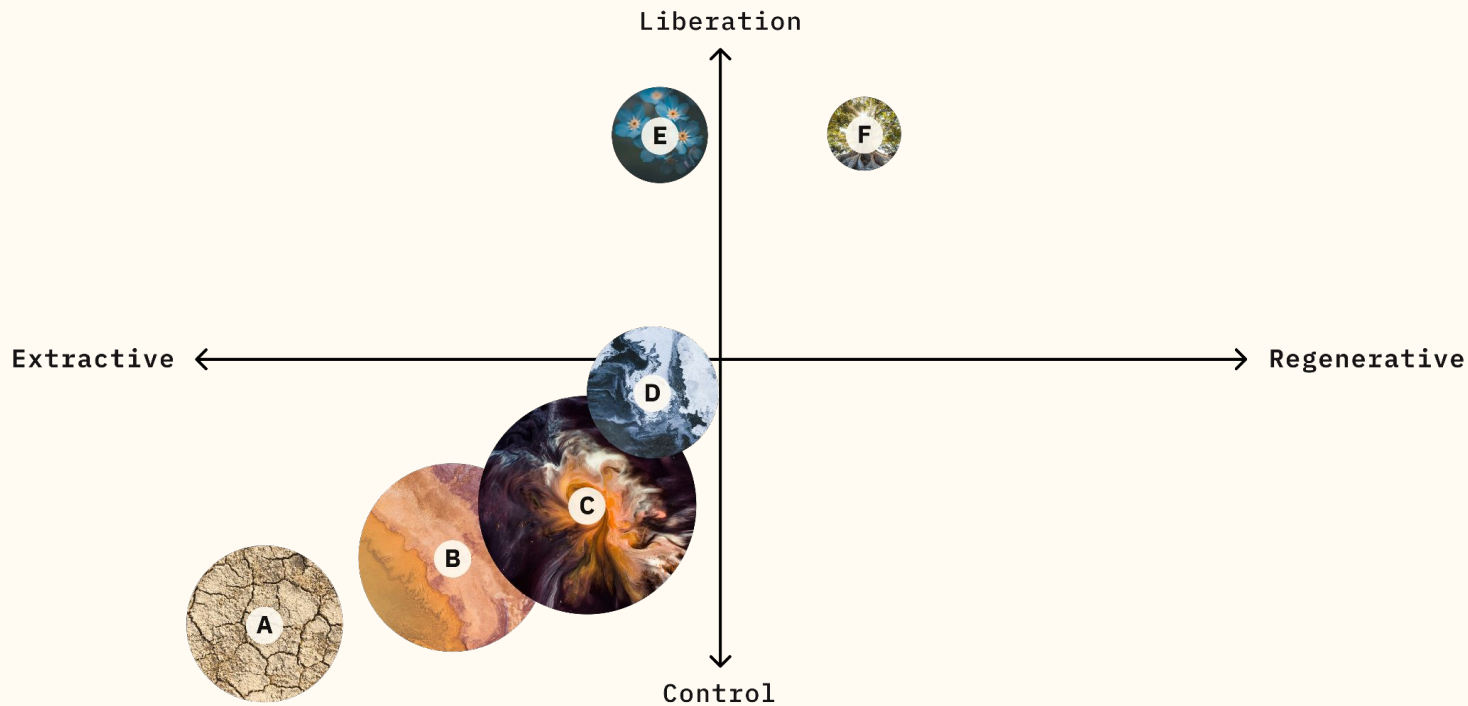

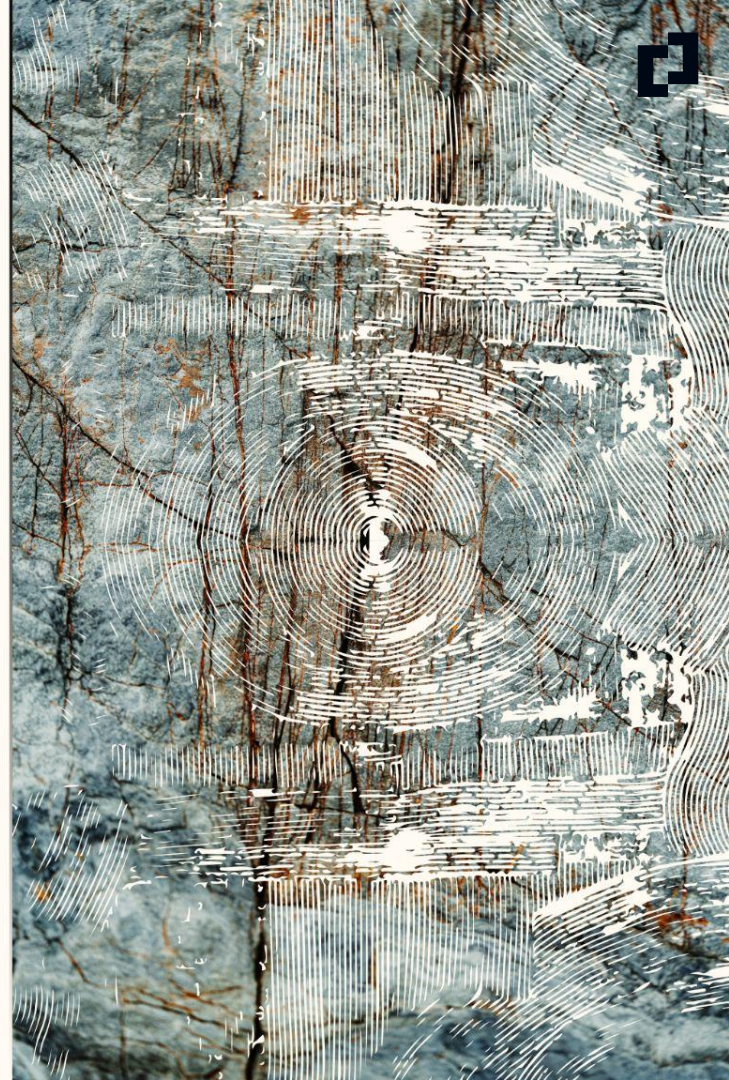



Window of Discourse

Reframe Strategy

The “Transition Pathway” frame affords several directions for our narrative strategy:

- It allows movements, foundations, individuals, etc. to **situate themselves** within a cognitive-development model for (syntropic) systems change.
- ‘Seeing’ the narrative system from this perspective **plots a pathway for change** that is aligned to an evolving set of values and outcomes.
- This provides goals for narrative change but also heuristics for each stage of transition.
- This transforms the ‘agenda-setting function’ of philanthropy to rather function as **energy, currency or nutrurance** within a complex, evolving and living system.
- Through this stakeholders can **develop collective and individual strategies** for change within this developmental pathway.

In this way, the Transition Pathway trope functions to develop a new **common sense of the essence and function of wealth.**
